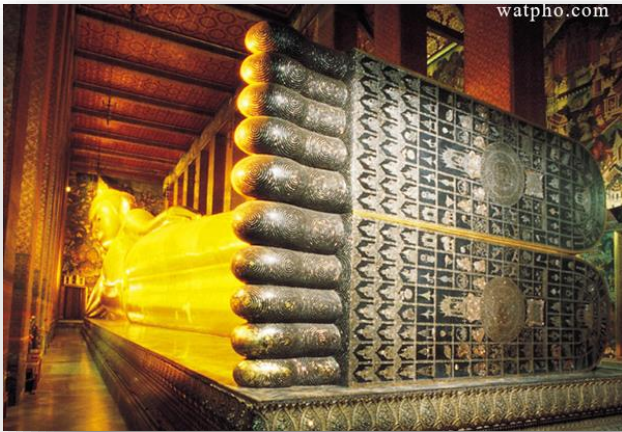


## Wat Pho



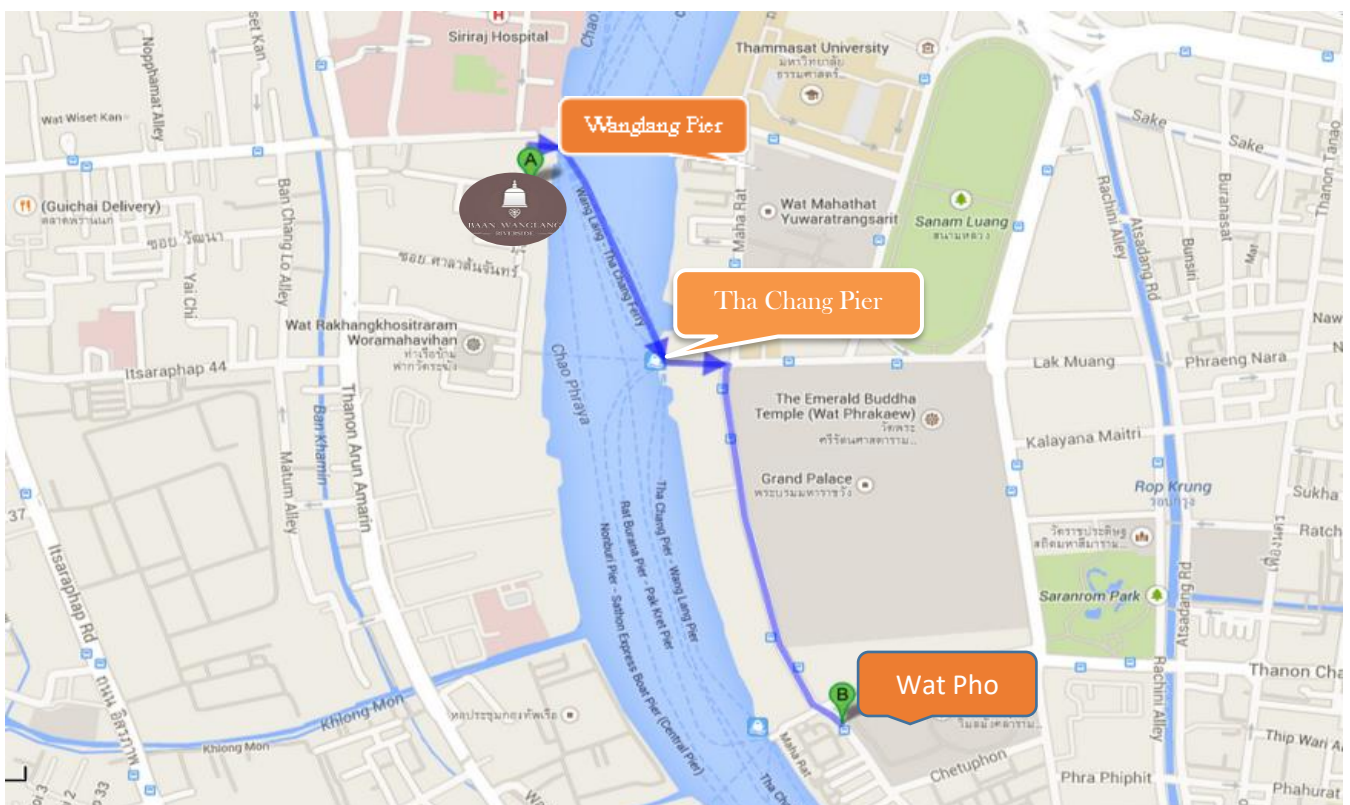
Wat Phra Chetuphon Wimon Mangkhalaram Ratchaworamahawihan or Wat Pho was one of Thailand's the most significant temples and dedicated to King Rama I. It's seen as Thailand's first university as the temple housed plaques inscribed with texts in various branches. The temple was recognized as Memory of the World Programmer by UNESCO in March 2008 Wat Pho house the great number of stupas in Thailand, totaling 99 stupas. The most significant is the great stupas of 4 rein commemorating King Rama I, King Rama II, King Rama III King Rama IV and famous Thai massage.
